

Team Up Competition Information Sheet
at Manor Grange Stud Show Centre

BD rules will apply with regards to saddlery and horse equipment. Protective headgear must be worn in accordance with BD rules. Numnahs/saddle cloths may be of any colour (bandages & boots are not permitted).

Jackets are not compulsory. Teams can wear 'team colours' of their own choice.

Horses may be plaited but not compulsory.

Commanders & whips are allowed.

Teams are comprised of 3 or 4 rider/horse combinations. Team Categories are 'Open' (team members to be of any age) or 'Under 16's' (Team members to be 16 years or under). Must state on entry form.

The 3 highest combined percentages will determine the team placings. In the event of teams achieving the same total percentage, the winning team is the one who's achieved the highest of the lowest scores.

Qualifying Competitions held at Manor Grange Stud are on:

Sunday 8th February 2015, Sunday 8th March, Sunday 15th March, Sunday 22nd March, Sunday 12th April, Saturday 18th April, Sunday 3rd May, Saturday 30th March, Sunday 7th June, Saturday 20th June, Saturday 4th July, Sunday 2nd August, Saturday 22nd August, Saturday 12th September, Saturday 3rd October. Finals Saturday 24th October.

Rosettes will be awarded to the highest 6 teams overall regardless of Open or Under 16's Category but will be split for the finals.

Team Up Points League

Points will be allocated to each team according to placings, as follows:

- 1st = 10 points
- 2nd = 9 points
- 3rd = 8 points
- 4th = 7 points
- 5th = 6 points
- 6th = 5 points
- 7th = 4 points
- 8th = 3 points
- 9th = 2 points
- 10th = 1 point

An on-going league results table will be published on the Manor Grange Stud Show Centre website.

The top 15 placed teams from the Open & Under 16's categories will qualify for the final at Manor Grange Stud Show Centre on Saturday 24th October 2015.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- Do the same riders have to compete at every competition?
If one of your team members can't make a competition date, don't worry, substitute them with another rider but please inform us of the change. If you qualify for the Finals in October, your final 4 team members must have competed in previous Team Up Competitions.
- My horse and I are in two Team Up teams, can we compete in the same class at the same show for both teams?
Yes you can! The same horse and rider combination may compete for two teams on the same day but must rider two separate tests. The rider must declare on the entry form which test will count for which team.
- I've got two horses, can I compete them both for the same team?
No, only one horse per rider in a team – you can compete then on separate teams, though.
- Me and my friend share a horse, can we both ride for the same team?
Yes, a horse can compete a maximum of two tests per competition, which means you can both ride!
